English

We will be writing newspaper articles, formal and informal letters and narratives

We are reading...



We will be focusing on:

- Parenthesis to show additional information
- Using reported speech for quotes.
- Relative clauses to add information about a noun.
- Using the correct level of formality.

In Guided Reading, we will be using our class text to answer retrieval and inference questions based on the story we are reading.

Maths

We will be looking at:

- Fractions
- Converting Units of Measure

We will learn:

- To find equivalent fractions and how to write them in their simplest form
- To add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions
- To find fractions of amounts
- To convert metric and imperial measures

Art

We will be learning about famous artists, the mediums they use and creating our own art work with our choice of techniques.

We will learn:

- To suggest ideas for the meaning behind a picture
- Understand and choose a meaningful message to convey through creating some different composition ideas.

Science

We are learning about light and reflection.

We will learn:

- How light travels
- How the eye is protected from light
- To make observations about the properties of light
- To use ray diagrams to explain why shadows change size



History

We will be learning about World War Two and its impact on Britain. We will have an evacuee experience day to understand what it felt like to be an evacuee at that time.

We will learn:

- Identify the causes of World War 2.
- Identify the different phases in the Battle of Britain.
- Make deductions about the Blitz from photographs.
- Describe how children may have felt when evacuated.
- Evaluate the accuracy, reliability and usefulness of sources

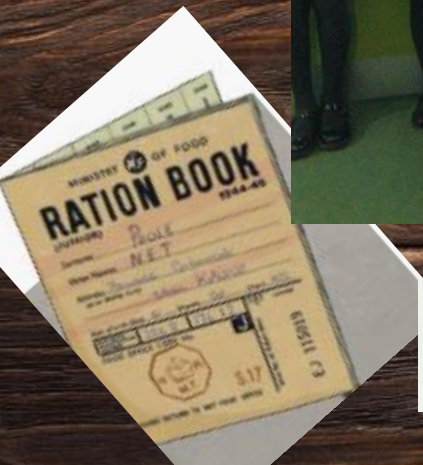
