Spring One in Year 5

English

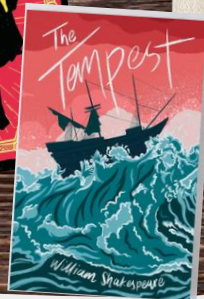
This term, we will read the historical fiction story *Treason* by Berlie Doherty, focusing on:

- Narrative writing
- Setting openings
- Character Viewpoint

We will also read *The Tempest* by William Shakespeare, where we will explore diary entries, sequels, and explanation writing.

These stories focus on our theme of Tudor life and literature.

We are reading...



French

We will learn about French money, numbers, and prices to prepare a list for shopping in a French market.

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Multiply and divide up to 4-digit numbers
- Fractions, integers, and finding fractions of amounts.
- Decimals and percentages.
- Perimeter and area.
- Statistics

Science

We will be exploring different types of mixtures and the appropriate methods to separate materials such as

- Sieving
- Filtering
- Dissolving
- Evaporating

We will work scientifically to research different mixtures to find out what substances it is made from.

Art

We will be developing our drawing skills by:

- Creating interesting portrait drawings using words.
- Experimenting with materials and techniques
- Constructing self-portraits that represent aspects of themselves.

We will also be creating portraits that link to our Topic Theme: Tudors.



History

We are Tudors

We will be learning what life was like in Tudor England.

We will also learn about:

- King Henry VIII- fair ruler or tyrant.
- King Henrys- why so many wives.
- Anne Boleyns life.
- Everyday Tudor life.



DT

We are learning how to design and make our own stuffed toys.

We are exploring techniques such as the blanket stitch and decorative stitching to bring our creations to life.

This term, we will be learning to sing 'Make You Feel My Love'.
